




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The collection

The exceptional collection Setdart presents, comprised of a set of 120 works, showcases the creative effervescence that has defined art from the 20th and early 21st centuries. Developed over a timeframe spanning from the second avant-gardes to the most current artistic expressions, the collection is, as a whole, a fascinating narrative of the legacy that artists of the caliber of Andy Warhol, Tom Wesselmann, Keith Haring, Christo, Jean Dubuffet, Karel Appel, Pierre Alechinsky, Peter Haley, Damien Hirst, Bernar Venet or Jan Fabre have bestowed upon recent history.

The wide range of media, from painting and sculpture to installations, conceptual art and photography, find a solid and revealing representation, becoming not only a vivid testimony of the evolution of artistic practice but also of our own evolution as a society.

Carefully selected over decades with expert eyes and a passion for art that shines through in each work, the collection immerses us through its most celebrated protagonists in the artistic movements that flourished after World War II. Alongside informalism, abstract expressionism, pop art, kinetic art, or land art, the most groundbreaking trends coexist, which have revitalized and renewed the artistic landscape in recent decades, particularly with the emergence of conceptual art.

In fact, one of the keys that make this collection particularly interesting lies in its ability to condense and build bridges between the multiple artistic movements of the 20th and 21st centuries, establishing a stimulating dialogue not only between avant-garde art and the latest trends but also between the United States and Europe as creative centers par excellence.

La colección

La excepcional colección que presentamos compuesta por un conjunto de 120 obras evidencia la efervescencia creativa que ha definido el arte del siglo XX y principios del XXI. La colección, desarrollada en un marco temporal que abarca desde las segundas vanguardias hasta las expresiones artísticas más actuales, es, en su conjunto, un fascinante relato del legado que artistas del calibre de Andy Warhol, Tom Wesselmann, Keith Haring, Christo, Jean Dubuffet, Karel Appel, Pierre Alechinsky, Peter Haley, Damien Hirst, Bernar Venet o Jan Fabre han brindado a la historia más reciente.

La amplia gama de medios, que, desde la pintura y escultura hasta las instalaciones, el arte conceptual y la fotografía, encuentran una sólida y reveladora representación se convierten no solo en un vívido testimonio de la evolución de la práctica artística, sino también de nuestra propia evolución como sociedad.

Cuidadosamente seleccionada a lo largo de décadas con un ojo experto y una pasión por el arte que transluce en cada obra, la colección nos sumerge a través de sus protagonistas más célebres en los movimientos artísticos que florecieron tras la Segunda Guerra Mundial. Junto al informalismo, el expresionismo abstracto el pop art el arte cinético o el land art, conviven las tendencias más rompedoras que durante las últimas décadas y a partir de la irrupción del arte conceptual, han dinamizado y renovado el panorama artístico

De hecho, una de las claves que hacen de esta colección un conjunto de especial interés radica en su capacidad para condensar y tender puentes entre los múltiples movimientos artísticos del siglo XX y XXI, estableciendo un estimulante diálogo no solo entre el arte de vanguardia y las últimas tendencias, sino también entre Estados Unidos y Europa como centros creativos por excelencia.



The collector and his story

Science and art intertwine at the origins of the artisan who brought this collection to light. With a scientific background but possessing innate intuition and creative spirit, our collector embarked on the exciting path of the contemporary art world as a result of his professional growth within the realm of advertising. His travels around the world afforded him the opportunity to discover what he calls “art in motion,” that which, amidst the hustle and bustle and frenetic pace of cities like New York, is capable of transforming everyday life.

Indeed, it was precisely in the city of New York, when the vision through the window of his plane of the thousands of saffron-colored waving banners that Christo had installed in his “Gates” in Central Park, that a need to experiment with contemporary art emerged, leading to his unstoppable passion for collecting. Speaking with him, we become aware of the profound significance he attributes to the act of collecting and, therefore, the transcendence and impact that art has had on his life trajectory. The epiphany he felt after encountering Christo’s work made him understand the transformative capacity of art, whose power transcends mere aesthetics to affect the deepest layers of the human psyche.

In this respect, each of the meticulously selected works embodies a narrative, a story waiting to be discovered and interpreted anew with each glance, constantly evolving as we do. In fact, the relationship established between art and science through many of the great artists that are part of the collection is further evidence of the inseparable link he sees between life and art, acting as two sides of the same coin that feed off and enrich each other.

El coleccionista *y su historia*

Ciencia y arte se entrelazan en los orígenes del artífice que dio luz a esta colección. De formación científica, pero con una intuición y espíritu creativo innato, nuestro coleccionista se inició en el apasionante sendero del mundo del arte contemporáneo a raíz de su crecimiento como profesional dentro del mundo de la publicidad. Sus viajes alrededor del mundo le brindaron la posibilidad de descubrir lo que él denomina “arte en movimiento”, aquel que, en mitad del bullicio y ritmo frenético de ciudades como Nueva York, es capaz de transformar la vida cotidiana.

De hecho, fue precisamente en la ciudad de New York cuando la visión, a través de la ventanilla de su avión, de los miles de pañuelos ondulantes de tonos azafranes que Christo había instalado en sus “Gates” de Central Park hizo aflorar una necesidad de experimentar con el arte contemporáneo, que desembocó en su irrefrenable pasión por el coleccionismo.

Hablando con él, tomamos conciencia de la profunda significación que le otorga al hecho de coleccionar y, por tanto, de la trascendencia e impacto que el arte ha supuesto en su trayectoria vital. La epifanía que sintió tras su encuentro con la obra de Christo le hizo entender la capacidad transformadora del arte, cuyo poder trasciende lo meramente estético para incidir en las capas más íntimas de la psique humana.

En este aspecto, cada una de las obras meticulosamente seleccionadas encarnan una narrativa, una historia esperando ser descubierta e interpretada de nuevo con cada mirada, evolucionando constantemente a medida que nosotros lo hacemos. De hecho, la relación que se establece entre el arte y la ciencia a través de muchos de los grandes artistas que forman parte de la colección, es una muestra más del vínculo indivisible que para él existe entre la vida y el arte, actuando como dos caras de una misma moneda que se retroalimentan y enriquecen entre sí.




Vanguards

After the end of the Second World War, a new stage shook the artistic landscape: the second avant-gardes began, ushering in a period of fertile and creatively intense activity in which different styles and movements succeeded each other at a frenetic pace. The political and cultural crisis that ravaged Europe favored the shift of the world's artistic capital from Paris to New York. In this sense, the collection we present reflects and promotes the dialogue established between the artistic proposals of both capitals. Led by influential artists such as Andy Warhol, David Hockney, Jean Dubuffet, Keith Haring, Sam Francis, Pierre Alechinsky, Victor Vasarely, Christo, and Yves Klein, we embark on an exciting journey that introduces us to informel art, continues with pop art, kinetic art, or new realism, until we reach the emergence of conceptual art.

As a whole, this collection of second avant-garde art is a testament to the power of art to challenge, inspire, and transform. Each piece is a window into a world of infinite possibilities, where imagination is the only limit. It is a reminder that art not only reflects reality but also redefines it.

Tras el fin de la Segunda Guerra Mundial, una nueva etapa sacudió el panorama artístico: se iniciaban las segundas vanguardias y con ellas un periodo, fértil y creativamente intenso en el que los diferentes estilos y movimientos se sucedían a un ritmo frenético. Latest trends

In recent decades, and following the rhythm set by the avant-gardes, artistic currents emerge and feed off each other with a fascinating speed, blurring the boundaries between the various trends that have shaped the current artistic landscape. The multiplicity of perspectives, cultural influences, and individual visions that make up contemporary artistic practice shine through the multitude of styles and techniques that, as conceptual art has already suggested, have revolutionized the very notion of art. Artists like Bernar Venet, Jan Fabre, Wim Delvoye, Joana Vasconcelos, and Koen Vanmechelen open the door to a universe as intimate as it is collective, with which they manage to challenge the viewer in as many ways as there are interpretations. Enigmatic, challenging, satirical, with philosophical and spiritual undertones... beyond the eternal debate about what is and isn't art, each of them is intrinsically linked to issues such as advertising, religion, popular culture, or politics that have marked contemporary society.

Obras enigmáticas, retadoras, satíricas, con tintes filosóficos y espirituales... más allá del eterno debate entre lo que es y no es arte, cada una de ellas está intrínsecamente unida a cuestiones que como la publicidad, la religión, la cultura popular o la política han marcado la sociedad contemporánea,












